Charter representatives met with FCC staff in three recent meetings to discuss compliance with the Federal Communication Commission's ("FCC") information and data requests in this proceeding.

During the meetings, Charter and its representatives sought clarification and guidance on the scope of the FCC's questions. The September 2 meeting primarily addressed the internal databases that Charter maintains and how data is tracked in these databases; the September 3 meeting involved clarification and questions regarding the FCC's requested data formatting; and the September 4 meeting focused on clarifications regarding the FCC's questions in light of the information that Charter maintains.

As part of this notice, please find enclosed two documents describing Charter's internal databases. The documents, which contain proprietary and non-public information, are being submitted on a Highly Confidential basis under the Joint Protective Order in effect in this proceeding.¹ Consistent with the instructions in the Joint Protective Order, the Highly Confidential version of this filing, complete with attachment, is being filed under separate cover, and copies are being provided to the Media Bureau.
