On Thursday, August 28, 2014, I met with Eric Cutright, IT Director of the Karuk Tribe, along with Irene Flannery, Robert Finley, and Karen Sprung of the Federal Communications Commission's Office of Native Affairs and Policy, together with Thomas Nessinger of the Media Bureau and Dorothy Stifflemire of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

During the meeting, Mr. Cutright identified certain issues regarding broadband network traffic management and service provider data caps, as well as varying economic models associated with these issues. Mr. Cutright encouraged the FCC to define the Open Internet rules in specific, technical terms to help ensure certainty and consistency for consumers.
