Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 2, 2014, along with Lynn Charytan of Comcast Corporation, I met with the following Commission staff regarding Request No. 51 in the Information and Data Request that was issued to Comcast on August 21, 2014: Hillary Burchuk, William Dever, and Jonathan Sallet. Specifically, we discussed the specific focus of the request, and discussed Comcast's view that the NBCUniversal transaction conditions are generally applicable other than those that have expired or are applicable specifically to NBCUniversal assets. The Commission staff affirmed that Request No. 51 is intended to elicit further information relevant to the statement on page 106 of the Public Interest Statement filed by Comcast and Time Warner Cable,¹ and that no specific form of response was envisioned.

We also asked for information concerning the standards and process the Commission would use with respect to any exceptions made to the ex parte rules in this proceeding.
