It also puts businesses, particularly new entrants in the market and those with less capital, at a clear competitive disadvantage. This will harm the economy in the long term. The proposed rule is poor public policy and should be rejected, and replaced by a rule that treats these corporate behemoths like the common carriers they are, as a practical matter.
