

I am a Rural Direct TV Customer, and i doubt the merger would benefit me in any way, and as (1) Direct TV (DTV) took 6 days to visit for a repair last week, and i think more customers will make their service time even worse; (2) i feel DTV overpays for much of its programming, and especially for the ESPN Stations, and my cost has increased every year i have been a customer with them; (3) AT&T's promise to make available rural Satellite broadband service is a poor promise, and as i doubt this service will be affordable; (4) AT&T's current bundling price is around \$50 more than i currently pay for individual Satellite TV, Wired/Wireless Broadband and Local Phone through Windstream, and Long Distance through Telna; (5) AT&T's admin fees, state and local taxes and fees for phone, satellite, etc. would be more than a nominal charge to customers. Lastly, i very much doubt that AT&T will work to keep prices affordable, or even relatively constant, and especially that At&T has no products i currently want.
