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The American people are watching a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that is not seeking to make the Internet better, but instead seeking to regulate it. The FCC could improve broadband delivery by auctioning off much-needed spectrum. Or it could get rid of some of its own burdensome rules that prevent companies from attracting investors and innovating. But instead of doing these things that would improve the Internet, the FCC is wasting its time in an obsessive drive to regulate. This tells the American people that once again, a Washington agency is working in a self-interested way to increase its own power at the expense of the free people it is meant to serve.
