Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the FCC's rules, we respectfully submit this notice to report a meeting by conference call between Paul Wright, Alex Friedmann, Lance Weber, David Ganim and Carrie Wilkinson of the Human Rights Defense Center; Lee Petro, counsel for Martha Wright, *et al.* (the "Petitioners"); and Rebekah Goodheart, Christine Sanquist (intern) and Wireline Competition Bureau: Kalpak Gude, Lynne Engledow, David Zesiger and Patrick Halley on September 12, 2014.

During the meeting, all parties discussed their communications with the ICS providers regarding further ICS reform. Mr. Wright stated HRDC's position that intrastate ICS rates must be capped and that the FCC must eliminate commissions and ancillary fee payments.

Also discussed was the need for additional evidence in the record regarding ICS intrastate rates and commissions to further inform the issues.
