I support the statements made in the various filings made on behalf of TDI. For example, they are correct in noting that software and workflow systems currently exist to enable programmers to accurately and effectively extract captions from long videos to include in clips for posting.

They are also correct that NAB and other posters are being disingenuous in their attempted definitions of "time-sensitive." The FCC has kindly provided programmers with sufficient time and forewarning to prepare their systems to support captioned clips.

Further, it is in the best interests for programmers to caption all clips - captioning enhances the searchability and aggregation of those clips, as they contribute to rich metadata.
