¹ As required by USAC, GCI uses SAC #619001 for reporting all of its Alaska wireline CETC lines and SAC #619014 (which was activated by USAC in Q4 2010) for reporting all of its Alaska wireless CETC lines. However, beginning January 2012 USAC began reporting high cost disbursements to GCI using four SAC numbers, rather than two: 619001 (GCI wireline remote); 619014 (GCI wireless remote); 989004 (GCI wireline non-remote); and 989007 (GCI wireless non-remote). Remote Alaska includes all of Alaska except the following: the ACS-Anchorage incumbent study area; the ACS-Juneau incumbent study area; the fairbankszone1 disaggregation zone in the ACS-Fairbanks incumbent study area, and the Chugiak 1 and 2 and Eagle River 1 and 2 disaggregation zone of the Matanuska Telephone Association incumbent study area. 47 C.F.R. § 54.307(e)(3)(i).
