I have been living in a long care facility for 5 years and was EXTREMELY HAPPY to find RFD-TV available on the limited number of TV stations available here. Watching two or three hours of the rural programming is like taking that three hour road trip "HOME" without leaving my chair.

I heard that guy at the meeting say "We are basically an urban area!" I would suggest that the man take a look at a map, or better yet take an airplane/helicopter ride and see exactly how much of the USA is rural.
