On September 16, 2014 Max Solondz of Verizon spoke on the phone with Robert Pavlak and Uri Livnat of the Office of Engineering and Technology. The parties discussed a draft of an upcoming presentation by the Spectrum and Receiver Performance Working Group to the Technology Advisory Council ("TAC") that included, among other things, a brief description of channel use surety, a security feature designed to prevent unauthorized use of spectrum in multi-tiered sharing regimes. In response to questions, Verizon provided the attached document to further explain the concept. Although the document describes channel use surety as applied to the 3.5 GHz band, it was meant for illustrative purposes only and was not offered as a Verizon proposal in the above-captioned proceeding.
